What is Midweek Advance?

This is a time each week set aside for Sunday School classes, small groups, and individuals to mobilize into assigned strategic areas of our city as part of our For the City - In the City strategy. You can view more about our For the City strategy by clicking [here](#).

What will this time look like each week?

We will meet at 6:00pm in Horne Hall each Wednesday for a brief rally and prayer time. We will then deploy into our assigned areas to prayer walk, engage people, search for persons of peace, and eventually start groups. We will end by 7:15pm each week so that families with children can get back to the church to pick up their children.

What parts of our city will we be prayer walking, engaging, etc.?

We have mapped 80 strategic residential areas within 1-square mile of Immanuel. Starting in the Fall of 2020, 41 of these areas have been assigned to adult Sunday School classes and groups. Click [here](#) to view a Google Map of these strategic areas.

Will childcare be provided?

Yes. We will have Midweek opportunities on campus for preschool, kids, and students from 6:00 - 7:30pm.

When weather or lack of daylight forces us inside, we will shift this time to a time of equipping, celebration, and concentrated prayer for the lost.
